Family Self-Sufficiency Program

A <u>voluntary</u> program that supports you with your goals and connects you to resources & services to help become economically self-sufficient.

Who can join the FSS program? Anyone who holds a Section 8 Voucher with LBHA and is motivated to reach goals is encouraged to apply. The FSS Program serves up to 100 participants at a time. A waiting list is formed when the program is full.

How does it work? Participants receive one-on-one support from an FSS Coordinator to help set goals to move towards self-sufficiency. FSS connects participants to resources and services to help reach goals and provides an opportunity to build assets both personally and financially.

IS THERE A FINANCIAL BENEFIT? YES, there <u>can</u> be a financial benefit to joining FSS!

Once enrolled in FSS, when your rent goes up because of an increase in <u>earned income</u>, generally the difference between your previous rent and your new rent amount will go into a FSS escrow savings account each month. When you graduate from the FSS Program, you receive the money that has been set aside for you.

2021 FSS STATISTICS: 16 Families Graduated from the FSS Program in 2021!

- 2021 graduates received over \$107,000 in total FSS Escrow funds!! (Average of \$6,744 per graduating family!)
- The average increase in annual earned income, based on enrollment & exit data for 2021 grads, was \$32,481 per household.
- 9 graduate families no longer need housing assistance.
- There were 2 homeowners in 2021! 26 current &/or graduated FSS clients are actively saving for homeownership!
